- 12. No man has seen God any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, AND HIS LOVE IS PERFECTED IN US.


ROMANS.5:8

1 CORINTHIANS.6:20 & 7:23


- 20. For ye are bought with a Price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit which are God's

HEBREWS.4:15-16

King David's Repentance

MARK.11:24-26

- 32. Should not thou also have had compassion on thy fellow servant, even as I had pity on thee?
- 33. And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pall that was due unto him.
- 34. So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you,, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.

2 PETERr.1:4



Secrets of the ZOHAR

Rav Aba approached the traveler and said: "What have you done that the Holy One, blessed be He, performed two miracles for you: saving you from the snake, and saving you from the falling cliff? For these events did not happen without a reason."

The traveler replied, "In all my day, I forgave and made peace with any man who did evil by me. If I could not make peace with him, I did not sleep on my bed before forgiving him and all others who had aggrieved me, and I did not harbor hatred for any harm that had been done to me. Moreover, from that day on, I tried to do kindness by them. "

Rav Aba wept and said: "This man's deeds exceeds those of Yosef, for those who injured Yosef were his brothers.

Assuredly, he should have pitied and forgiven them from brotherhood. But this man was forgiving of every one, so he is greater than Yosef and is worthy to have the Holy One, blessed be He, perform one miracle after the other for his sake.
